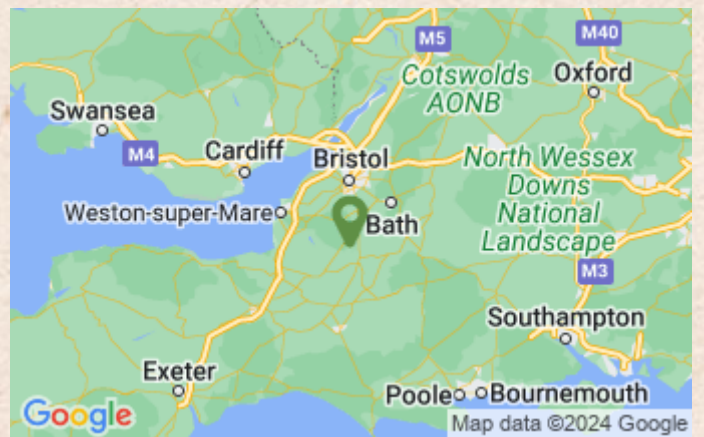



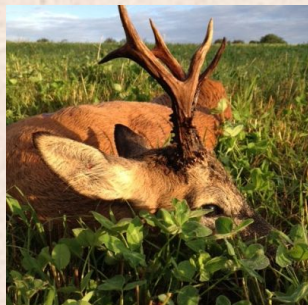
HUNTING AREA The Mendips
